Outline of Service Provided	<p>A confidential 1:1 mental health service for children and young people which works predominantly on-site in schools. The service currently operates in the following comprehensives on a regular, weekly basis: Aston, Brinsworth (from Sept 2007), Clifton, Dinnington, Rawmarsh, Thrybergh, Wath and Maltby (in partnership with Maltby BEST). Appointments are offered during lesson times or by drop-in at lunchtimes.</p> <p>Referrals to our short term intervention service can be made for children and young people in other schools but a maximum of 6 sessions will be offered. This service may be subject to a waiting list.</p> <p>The service also offers training to other professionals in Tier 1 universal services on a range of mental health issues which impact on children and young people i.e. Bullying, Bereavement, Self Injury, Eating Disorders and Feeling Down.</p>
Referral	Referrals made by schools, other agencies, parents or self-referral. Referral form available on request
Restrictions on work carried out e.g. age group/funding/geographical area	Referrals from Rotherham Borough only. Most of young people seen are of secondary school age but the service will see children at KS2 if appropriate, and 18-25, by negotiation with referrer.
