Outline of Service Provided	<p>A confidential 1:1 mental health service for children and young people which works predominantly on-site in schools. The service currently operates in the following comprehensives on a regular, weekly basis: Aston, Brinsworth, Clifton, Dinnington, Rawmarsh, Swinton, Thrybergh, Wath, Wickersley, Wingfield, Winterhill and Maltby (in partnership with Maltby BEST). Appointments are offered during lesson times or by drop-in at lunchtimes.</p> <p>In addition, a 6-session short term intervention service is offered to Oakwood, St Bernards, St Pius and Wales Comprehensive Schools, as well as 2 primary schools.</p> <p>The service also offers training to professionals in Tier 1 universal services on a range of mental health issues. This training supports ECM and the delivery of SEAL, and includes: Bullying, Bereavement, Self Injury, Disordered Eating, Counselling Skills, Healthy Anger, Working Therapeutically with Children & Young People to understand poor mental health.</p>
Referral	<p>Referrals made by schools, other agencies, parents or self-referral. Referral form available on request.</p>
Restrictions on work carried out e.g. age group/funding/geographical area	<p>Referrals from Rotherham Borough only. The service is usually limited to the schools it works in, but on occasion can offer other support to KS2 children and young people within the 18-25 age.</p>
