Agency/Sector	Police and Young Peoples Partnership Officer- PYPPPO
Contact details	Based within Locality Teams - ask school staff for contact details.
Outline of Service Provided	<p>The role of the PYPPPO attached to each locality team will link closely with the Safer Neighbourhoods Team and schools regarding all youth crime and disorder related issues.</p> <p>A PYPPPO may become involved if you have concerns with regards to Anti Social Behaviour, Drugs or Alcohol Misuse, sexual activity etc.</p>
Referral	<p>Either a parent/carer or the young person can self refer. This can either be done by calling Social Care Front Desk 01709 382121 ext 4001 or by speaking with a member of staff in school.</p> <p>If your child has been involved with the police and has recently received a final warning, a referral to the PYPPPO will also be made.</p> <p>Once a referral has been made to the PYPPPO they will contact you and arrange to meet with you and the young person to discuss what service could be offered.</p>
Restrictions on work carried out e.g. age group/funding/ geographical area	<p>Referrals are restricted to ages 10 - 17 however, in exceptional circumstances this could be looked at for individual cases.</p>
