Outline of Service Provided	Educational support is provided from first diagnosis through to school leaving age. At pre-school, qualified teachers of the hearing impaired are able to work with parents to help babies and children to develop language and learning skills, through home visits and also through the parent/carer support group. Advice, training and support are also offered to playgroups and nurseries. Once a child enters school, visiting teachers of the hearing impaired continue to provide training and support.
Referral	Referrals can be made by Health Services, schools and parents. Details would be taken over the phone.
Restrictions on work carried out e.g. age group/funding/geographical area	The service works within the Rotherham Education Authority Boundaries. Term time only.
