<b>Agency/Sector</b>	<b>Police and Young Peoples Partnership Officer- PYPPPO</b>
<b>Contact details</b>	Based within some Locality Teams - ask school staff for contact details.
<b>Outline of Service Provided</b>	<p>The role of the PYPPPO attached to each locality team will link closely with the Safer Neighbourhoods Team and schools regarding all youth crime and disorder related issues.</p> <p>A PYPPPO may become involved if you have concerns with regards to Anti Social Behaviour, Drugs or Alcohol Misuse, sexual activity etc.</p>
<b>Referral</b>	<p>Either a parent/carer or the young person can self refer. This can either be done by calling Access Team Children and Young peoples services (CYPS) Social Care. Monday to Friday 01709 823987. Out of hours 01709 364689 or by speaking with a member of staff in school.</p> <p>If your child has been involved with the police and has recently received a final warning, a referral to the PYPPPO will also be made.</p> <p>Once a referral has been made to the PYPPPO they will contact you and arrange to meet with you and the young person to discuss what service could be offered.</p>
<b>Restrictions on work carried out e.g. age group/funding/geographical area</b>	Referrals are restricted to ages 10 - 17 however, in exceptional circumstances this could be looked at for individual cases.
